## Points System Committee

The Points System Award is designed to provide scholarships to the membership of KSPAN for educational offerings ASPAN/KSPAN, certification or recertification or applied toward membership renewal.

The Points System Form is the application point and can be printed from the KSPAN web site. A number of points are assigned to a number of opportunities that the Committee agreed were required as a Perianesthesia nurse, an ASPAN/KSPAN member and includes volunteer activities at both the employment and community levels.

These points are tabulated and the application submitted to the Secretary prior to the yearly Fall Conference in November. The Secretary and her designee review the forms and re-tabulate the numbers to determine the winners.

We award a highest number winner, of the general membership, \$250 and the runner-up \$150 to be used within a 2-year time frame.

We also award the same for the Board of Directors.

At least 75% of the combined activities should be ASPAN/KSPAN related.

Since this is a scholarship award, starting this year we are going to attach a form for Validation. The activities listed will need to be verified by a fellow KSPAN member, department director/manager or Charge Nurse when submitted.

We are always looking to improve the form and any suggestions are appreciated.

I urge you to print the form now and start the completion process while the year is young and submit by the application date at the top of the form and send to the KSPAN mailing address.

I would like to see many applications for review in November.

This application form must be completed in full and submitted with documentation that demonstrates that the eligibility criteria has been met. Application materials must be submitted to the ABPANC National Office no later than February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Once documentation of eligibility criteria is confirmed, the Component President will be notified about the award presentation. Each Component receiving *the Shining Star Award* is invited to send a representative, as ABPANC's guest, to accept the award at the Celebration Event.

A Component may apply for the *Shining Star Award* on an annual basis. Eligibility criteria can be obtained from the ABPANC web site. KSPAN has never applied for this award but is currently in process.

### Celebrate Certified Nurses Day on March 19th - Start Planning Now!

Certified Nurses Day is a national day of recognition for certified nurses. It began as a dream in 2008 as the idea of ANCC staff member which quickly ignited the imaginations of American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) staff. Certified Nurses Day™ is a special day of recognition to celebrate the contribution of board certified nurses to the advancement of nursing professionalism and to higher standards and better outcomes in patient health.

What better response than to give certified nurses their own annual day of recognition!

Why March 19th? ANCC selected March 19th in honor of one of the greatest nursing leaders in the field of certification. March 19th was the birthday of Margretta "Gretta" Madden Styles, RN, EdD, FAAN; Dr. Styles was a visionary scholar with an international impact on the profession of nursing. Dr. Styles was born March 19, 1930 in Mount Union, Pennsylvania and passed away on Nov. 20, 2005.

## Giving and Receiving through ASPAN's Up and Comer's Initiative

It wasn't until becoming an ASPAN Regional Director that I became acquainted with the Up and Comer's Initiative. As an ASPAN Regional Director, I was assigned to lead a table discussion at CDI in Portland, Maine on "The Benefits of Membership in a Professional Organization". It was during preparation for CDI that I realized the impact of The Up and Comer's Initiative as a part of ASPAN's strategic plan identify and coach potential ASPAN leaders. As professional organizations seek to replace leaders, as those leaders progress to retirement, it is imperative that knowledge and expertise be shared with a new generation of leaders. The best way to pass knowledge and expertise is through a Mentor/Mentee program which also happens to serve as the basis of ASPAN's Up and Comer's Initiative.

Several years ago (approximately 30), I became interested in learning about mentoring relationships in nursing. This interest led to my thesis topic, "Mentoring Relationships in Nursing: A Descriptive Study". In doing a literature review on mentoring in nursing, I came upon an extremely interesting piece of research. The title alone caught my eye, "Assessments related to Cardiogenic Shock: Discovery of Nursing Gestalt", in conjunction with "Gray Gorillas". This study's aim was to determine what variables influence decision-making skills of critical care nurses. The study specifically examined cognitive processes used by veteran critical care nurses and how those processes were passed on to neophyte critical care nurses. The cognitive process used by veteran nurses was given the name, "Gray Gorilla Syndrome" with the veteran nurses, termed "Gray Gorillas". Investigators found that the Gray Gorillas used a teaching/learning process involving previous knowledge, past experiences, gut feelings, and patient related cues to transform their novice critical care nurses to the experts that they had become. In the wild, Gray Gorillas are silverback gorillas who lead, guide, teach, protect, and serve as role models for the group just as these experts were in coaching their protégés. ASPAN is fortunate to have many, many "Gray Gorillas" who are waiting for the opportunity to lead, guide, and mentor any member who desires to learn more about our professional organization.

Finally, I would like to share a poem with you by Thomas Gaines. The poem can be found on the back page of a book by Jay Rifenburg, "No Excuses! Incorporating Core Values, Accountability, and Balance into Your Life and Career".

### GIVING AND RECEIVING

"I launched a smile: far out it sailed on life's wide, troubled sea. And many more than I could count came sailing back at me. I clasped a hand while whispering, 'The clouds will melt away'.
